Pour la partition il y a 4 dièses à la clef: le Do#, le Ré#, le Fa# et le Sol#.

Pour la batterie il y a également quelques mises en place en doubles-croches qui ne sont pas faciles à effectuer mais c'est probablement la seule difficulté pour ce morceau.
