Introduction:

Pour les deux instruments: ce morceau est très difficile, il y a beaucoup de changements de métrique (6/8 – 4/4 – 5/4 – 6/4 - etc.) et les parties instrumentales sont très techniques (c'est souvent le cas avec le groupe Rush)

Une ligne de basse très compliquée à jouer car le tempo est assez rapide, les difficultés sont les accents, les contretemps, les glissés, les hammers, les notes courtes, une note muette et les syncopes.

La partie de batterie est également très compliquée à jouer. Les difficultés sont les accents, les contretemps en doubles-croches à la grosse caisse, les crescendos, les flas et pas mal de breaks différents avec un mélange binaire / ternaire, pensez à muter la cymbale sur les dernières mesures du solo de guitare (notes avec un point indiqué au dessus). **Attention ! J'utilise une écriture différente pour la hauteur des toms par rapport aux autres partitions qui sont disponibles sur mon site, consultez l'écriture de la batterie qui est située à la fin de ce dossier.**




